crossed

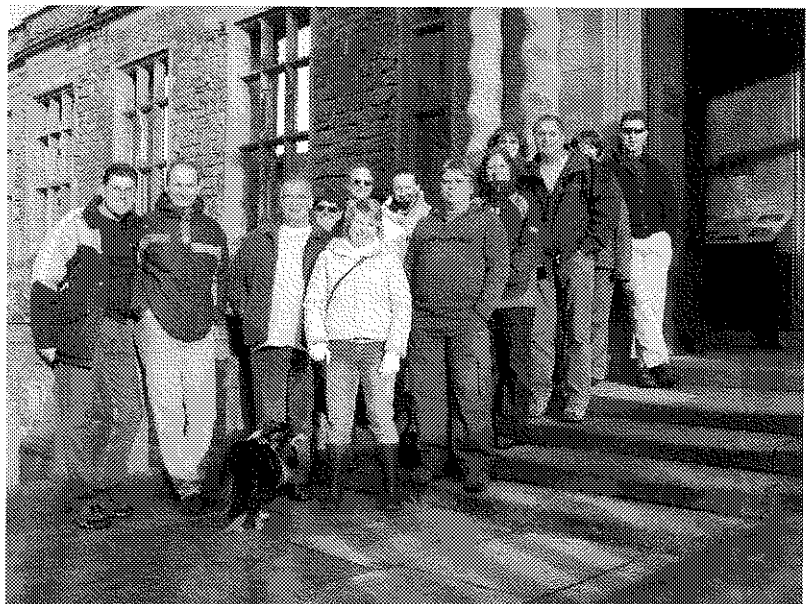
matched against the master
